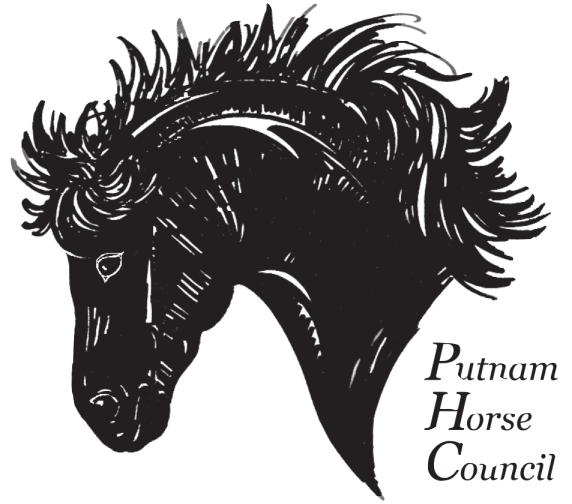

Associated Bridle Trails – Fall Pace Series 2009

Sunday, September 6, 2009

9:00 AM – 12:00 (*Rain or Shine*)

Any team leaving the start line after 12 noon, can ride the trail but time will not be counted in the division average. Be sure to get there in plenty of time to get out before noon.

**Putnam County Park
Gipsy Trail Road, Carmel, NY**

The course is six to seven miles long and starts from Putnam County Park. It includes fields, dirt roads, hills and trails. Most jumps are 2' to 2'6"; all have go-rounds.

DIVISIONS:

Ten ribbons will be awarded in each division after completion of Pace.

Division A – Hunt – for those teams wishing to ride at a faster pace.

Division B – Pleasure – for those teams wishing to go at a slower pace.

Division C – Junior – at least one rider age 18 or under. Riders under 14 must be accompanied by an adult.

Division D – Western – at least one person must ride with western tack.

STARTING TIMES:

Teams will start at 3 minute intervals. Starting times will be assigned on a first come, first served basis upon RECEIPT OF ENTRY CONTRIBUTION. Please indicate a 15 minute window for your start time (ie: 10:00 – 10:15).

Time will be taken from the start of the first team member to the finish of the last team member in each respective division. Entire team must complete course to qualify. Awards based on teams coming closest to the ideal (average) time. *Points earned towards trophies in Associated Bridle Trails Series.*

Overtaking teams have right of way. Horses that kick must wear red ribbon on tail.
